

1) One-to-One ABA Services:

An ABA program is individualized for the client's unique strengths and goals. It is carried out in an intensive, one-on-one format with an ABA therapist and data is collected and tracked throughout in order to monitor progress.

Intake Meeting and Program Development - \$330

This includes:

- Informal meeting with parents and child (1 hour)
- Program and curriculum development, including development of data sheets and program materials (1 hour)
- Parents receive brief report with program summary and suggestions (1 hour)

ABA Assessment (as needed) - \$110/hour

Senior Therapist will:

- Complete an ABA skills assessment (eg: ABLLS, VBMAPP, ESDM)
- Update the assessment and goals as needed (every 6 months)

Ongoing 1:1 ABA Therapy - \$55/hour

ABA Therapist:

- Work directly with the client, following goals outlined by the senior therapist
- Communicate with team and parents on a regular basis
- Complete and update data sheets and behaviour tracking

Senior Therapist (typically 10% of the ABA hours):

- Monitor and update the ABA program on a regular basis to ensure progress
- Directly observe the ABA program and provide feedback
- Training and support to the ABA therapist
- Communicate with parents and the team regularly

2) School Consultation Services (no behaviour plan) - \$100/hour, minimum of 2 hours billed:

School consultation is for students who may benefit from recommendations and strategies provided by a senior ABA therapist.

It includes:

- Observation of the student in their school/classroom
- Follow-up meeting with teachers to provide strategies and suggestions
- Brief summary report and feedback to parents
- Ongoing training and support as needed (as per hourly rate)

School Consultation with Behaviour Plan - \$100/hour, minimum of 3 hours billed:

School consultation is for students who may benefit from recommendations and strategies provided by a senior ABA therapist.

It includes:

- Observation of the student in their school/classroom
- Follow-up meeting with teachers to provide strategies and suggestions
- Brief summary report and feedback to parents
- Ongoing training and support as needed (as per hourly rate)

3) Behaviour Consultation and Support:

For intervention that is required for behaviour management at home or at school. Students who are receiving ABA therapy for behaviour management, will likely also need to purchase parent coaching sessions and/or school consultations in order to generalize the skills learned.

Functional Behaviour Assessment - \$100/hour

- Informal interview and assessment with parents and/or teachers
- Observation of the client in the natural environment
- Development of function-based behaviour plan with both antecedent and consequence strategies
- Training and support to implement and carry out the behaviour plan

ABA Therapy for Behaviour Management - \$65/hour (less than 3 hours a week)

- One-to-one behaviour therapy targeting specific behaviour management goals
- With senior ABA therapist

Parent Coaching - \$100/hour

- Parents will work directly with a Senior Therapist in choosing, implementing, and tracking specific behaviour goals for improvement at home
- Provide parents with basic training in behaviour principles and strategies to decrease challenging behaviour and increase skills

Additional Consultation Rates are Charged for the Following Items:

- Team meetings and/or meetings with other specialists on your child's team
- Consultation with classroom teachers
- Phone calls over 30 minutes per week
- Report writing
