- Working with small groups of students in a classroom
- Implement reinforcement systems and behaviour plans in the classroom
- Implement social skills curriculum in the classroom
- Implementing goals
- Collect and graph data
- Prepare for ABA sessions
- Maintain client binders and materials
- Collaborate with interdisciplinary team
- Attend training sessions, workshops, online courses, etc.
- Maintain daily written communication log with families
- Demonstrate therapy sessions to professionals and families as required
- Uphold Centre's policies and procedures (including ethical guidelines)
