### **Role: Aquatics Instructor/Lifeguard**

Kayla's Children Centre is looking for enthusiastic, experienced, and dedicated lifeguards to join our team. As a Lifeguard, you will support the vision of creating the most meaningful and healthy futures for all children, youth, and families by providing a safe aquatic environment for children, youth, and adults who do and don't have disabilities in a fully integrated setting. You will provide supervision for our non-instructional and recreational aquatics program.

#### **As a hybrid Instructor/Lifeguard, you will be responsible for:**

- Monitoring instructional and recreational swimming activities, including patrolling the pool deck and scanning the water, as well as monitoring patrons and volunteers to ensure a safe swim environment.
- Instructing and leading group or individual lessons: creating and implementing weekly lesson plans.
- Enforcing the Ministry Health Regulations, maintaining appropriate daily records and documentation, and reporting any relevant information to the appropriate supervisor.
- Carrying an aid at all times, performing emergency rescues to the standard of your certifications, responding to patron inquiries, resolving problems, and performing associated public education duties.
- Setting up the pool deck prior to your shift & cleaning the deck following your shift.
- Attendance at all scheduled staff training.
- Keeping all awards current.
- Performing other duties as assigned.

#### **Minimum Knowledge, Skills, & Abilities**

- Minimum 18 years of age
- Standard First Aid with CPR Level C
- National Lifeguard Service
- Successful candidates will be required to provide a satisfactory Vulnerable Sector Check
- National Lifeguard Instructor as asset
